

South Texas Reining Horse Association By-Law Amendment proposal

Current Article:

Article II. Governance

Section 1.

The governing body of this organization shall be a Board of Directors consisting of the following officers: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Immediate Past President and six (6) Directors.

Proposed By-Law Change:

Article II. Governance

Section 1.

The governing body of this organization shall be a Board of Directors consisting of nine (9) Directors and the Immediate Past President. The Directors shall be elected by the Members. The Board of Directors shall elect a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer at the first meeting after the annual election.

Current Article:

Article II. Governance

Section 2.

All officer and directors shall be elected for two-year terms with terms of the directors staggered. Five (5) directors (two (2) officers and three (3) directors) shall be elected for terms starting on even numbered years, and five (5) directors (two (2) officers and three (3) directors) starting on odd numbered years. Even year officer elections will be the President and Treasurer. Odd year officer election will be Vice-President and Secretary.

Proposed By-Law Change:

Article II. Governance

Section 2.

All Directors shall be elected for three-year terms with the terms of the directors staggered at three Directors newly elected per year. Each of the Directors' initial terms shall begin on the date immediately following the annual meeting of the members.

Section 3.

There shall be no limitation of the number of terms which officers and directors are allowed to serve.

Proposed By-Law Change:

Section 3.

There shall be no limitation of the number of terms which directors are allowed to serve.

Current Article:

Article III. Election of Officers

Section 1.

Nominations for officers and directors due for election shall be submitted by a committee appointed by the president from members of the Board of Directors. This Nomination Committee will submit to the President not less than 60 days prior to the annual meeting a list of persons able and willing to stand for the positions due for election.

Proposed By-Law Change:

Article III. Election of Officers

Section 1.

Nominations for directors due for election shall be submitted by a committee appointed by the president from members of the Board of Directors. This Nomination Committee will submit to the President not less than 30 days prior to the election a list of persons able and willing to stand for the director positions due for election.
